

PRESENTATION OF WORKS REQUIREMENTS

1. The individual or collective papers will have to be related necessarily to some of the thematic main topic of the program of III the World-wide Congress on Rights of the Childhood and the Adolescence.
2. The maximum extension of the works will be of 30 pages, DIN A4, and the minimum of 10 pages, to space of interline simple, letter Times New Roman, number 12.
3. People who present paper will have to register in the Congress in the modality of reduced fee. In case of works of collective responsibility, is understood that the co-authors have to register individually as congressmen if they try to attend the event.
4. Abstracts: with the inscription (reduced fee) will have to be enclosed, by electronic mail (iravetllat@ub.edu), a summary of its paper, with a maximum extension of one page, DIN A4, to space of interline simple, letter Times New Roman, number 12. It must be indicated of form needs the title of the work, the thematic main topic in which it is included, as well as the personal and professional data and the electronic mail of the authors.
5. The inscription to reduced fee is conditioned to the acceptance by the Scientific Committee of the "abstract" presented and to the delivery, in time and form, of the definitive text of the paper.
6. The complete text of the paper will have to be sent to the Secretariat of the Congress by electronic mail (iravetllat@ub.edu) before the 30th of September of 2007.
7. Abstract accepted will be published in the Web page of the Congress and the definitive papers will be included in the documentation that will be given to the attending public to the Congress.
8. By organizational criteria, between the received papers, the Scientific Committee of the Congress will select those that could be exposed during the space reserved in each one of the thematic sessions, as well as its possible publication in the book of materials of the Congress.
9. After the selection made by the Scientific Committee of the contributions for its exhibition, will be communicated with time to the congressmen the moment and concrete time which they have for it. The public exhibition of the selected papers will not be able to exceed 10 minutes of duration. The technical resources needed will be able to be asked previously to the organization, considering the limitation of time for these exhibitions.
10. Certification: the accepted papers give right to receive the supporting document.
